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As a dental health care provider (dental hygienist), I support this bill and believe it would be helpful if dentists can provide vaccines with appropriate training. HPV is currently the most common form of oral cancer and can be deadly. However, I would like to see consideration of line 32 on p. 4 of the bill (Line 32 9. A dentist shall not delegate the administration of a vaccine under this section) amended to allow licensed dental hygienists to be delegated to help with this if they have a local anesthesia permit and training. In 20 other states, properly trained dental hygienists have been able to give the COVID-19 vaccines through the pandemic under emergency situations under appropriate supervision. Testimony In Favor of HB 249 / SB270– Vaccination Administered by DentistMy name is Dr. Guy Deyton. I am the immediate past director of the Office of Dental Health in the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. I am a past member of the Missouri Dental Board, the regulatory agency that develops and enforces the rules regulating dental practice. I am a past president of the Missouri Dental Association. I have 38 years experience in both private practice and public health. I am offering testimony in favor of HB249 / SB270.Before I tell you why I think HB 249 / SB 270 is a very good idea, I want to state again that I am retired from all those roles I listed above. My testimony is my personal opinion based on 38 years of service in the public and private sector. I am not an official spokesperson for any of the organizations listed above.My role with the Missouri Dental Board involved 2 instances where the Board was asked to consider changes to the scope of practice of oral healthcare workers. One had to do with regulating outpatient sedation. The other had to do with establishing a new category of oral healthcare worker to improve access to care. In both situations, we asked and answered 3 questions to move forward with a decision. I think those questions are relevant to consideration of this bill. I will pose the 3 questions, give you my responses for your consideration, and provide documentation supporting my recommendation. The three questions are:1: Why is a change in scope of practice necessary or good for the people of Missouri?2: Does the recommended change in scope pose any risks to patients and is the affected healthcare worker equipped to manage those risks?3: Does the healthcare worker currently have the skills to execute the procedures involved? If not, what training should be required?Question 1: Why is this change in scope of practice necessary or good for the people of Missouri?The simple fact is that the post Covid-19 healthcare workforce in the United States and in Missouri is significantly short-handed, particularly in the area of primary care. The projections are it will get worse. Primary care providers are the ones that give vaccines and they need help. The following provides you documentation of the workforce shortage and the need for help. • The Health Resources and Services Administration’s (HRSA) Bureau of Health Workforce (BHW) estimates that Missouri currently has a 13% shortage of primary care practitioners (physicians, physician assistants & nurse practitioners practicing family medicine, general pediatric medicine, general internal medicine, and geriatric medicine)(1). The shortages are because our healthcare workforce was strained before the pandemic and devastated by the pandemic. • A survey of primary care healthcare workers during the pandemic estimated that 18 % quit their jobs. Among those that stayed in their jobs 19 % were considering leaving health care.(2)• A survey of 6,000 nurses by the American Association of Critical-Care Nurses found that 25% said they were planning to leave primary care in the next 3 years.(3)• According to the 2022 Missouri Hospital Association Workforce Report, Missouri experienced a 22.4% turnover rate for RN’s in 2022 and there are over 8000 unfilled vacancies for RN’s in Missouri.(4)• Due to the projected long-term shortage of primary healthcare providers we’re going to need to become more flexible in the

deployment of healthcare workers, particularly in the area of preventive health. Dentists are willing to help deliver vaccines. A survey 556 dentists published in the medical journal Plos One in 2022 indicated that 58% of the surveyed dentists were willing to deliver vaccines in their office. The article concluded that dentists "role in primary health care preventive strategies, including vaccinations, should be explored further." (5) In my own experience, organizing the first community wide Covid-19 vaccination event in Kansas City in February of 2021 at Bartle Hall, 68 dentists volunteered on very short notice to help. Question 2: Does the recommended change in scope pose any risks to patients and is the affected healthcare worker equipped to manage those risks? The most significant risk to patients getting a vaccine, or any other medication for that matter, is an allergic reaction. The incidence of allergic reactions to vaccines is very, very small. The highest incidence of allergic reaction to a drug is to penicillin, the most commonly prescribed drug by dentists. For that reason, dentists have extensive training in responding to drug related allergic reactions. Supporting documentation follows:

- The following are the typical incidences of allergic reactions to some vaccines and drugs:
  - o Penicillin: 5% (1 /20) 5
  - o Sulfa antibiotics: 3% (3/100)6
  - o Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine: 0.0003% (3/1,000,000)
  - o Pfizer Covid-19 vaccine: 0.0025% (2.5/1,000,000)
  - o Shingrix Shingles vaccine: 0.0015% (1.5/1,000,000)
  - o For example, it is 17,000 times less likely a patient will have an allergic reaction to the HPV vaccine than to a dose of penicillin taken at a dental office.

All US accredited dental schools have a required sequential curriculum to prepare dentists to respond to allergic reactions. At UMKC School of Dentistry dental students are exposed to the mechanisms and treatment of allergic reactions in 5 courses over 3 years. The relevant UMKC curriculum is listed below.

Question 3: Does the healthcare worker currently have the skills to execute the procedures involved? If not, what training should be required? Dentists are skilled at giving injections. The average dentist gives between 5 and 12 injections per day in the mouth, one of the most sensitive areas of the body. Other than an allergist, there probably are not other healthcare professionals that are more practiced at giving injections. In terms of training, a short vaccine review course approved by the Missouri Dental Board would be a good prerequisite to prepare dentists to provide vaccinations. When I organized the Covid-19 vaccination event in Kansas City, we held a half-day review for volunteers. It covered:

- o Reviewing the vaccine inserts for proper vaccine handling,
- o Medical history screening for higher risk patients,
- o Vaccine informed consent discussions and documentation
- o Post vaccination patient observation and documentation
- o Documenting the vaccinations in ShowMeVax, the Missouri system for tracking vaccination
- o Participation and documentation in VAERS, the federal vaccine adverse events reporting system

Our vaccination event in Kansas City vaccinated 1250 people against Covid-19. We had 2 adverse reactions, both were anxiety reactions from which the patient recovered in a matter of minutes. Dentists see these reactions every day in their office. Conclusion There are only 3 reasons I can think of that someone might oppose this legislation:

- They are not fully aware of the shortage of primary healthcare workers in Missouri and the projections that this shortage will worsen.
- They are not fully aware that dental education prepares dentists to safely administer injections and manage rare adverse reactions to vaccines should they occur.
- They are resistant to the need to recruit help for our primary care providers, especially in the area of prevention.

I am writing to express my strong support of HB 249 that would expand the scope of practice of dentistry to include prescribing and administering vaccines for diseases related to care within the practice of dentistry. As a dentist and public health professional, I believe this bill would greatly benefit the people of Missouri. Every hour, every day, an American dies from oral cancer. Over recent decades, the rates of oral cancer associated with tobacco and alcohol use have decreased in the United States, but rates of oral cancer associated with human papillomavirus (HPV) are increasing at an alarming rate. HPV is a common infection that can lead to various types of cancer, including oral cancer in the back of the mouth and throat, also known as oropharyngeal cancer. Thankfully, oropharyngeal cancer is also highly preventable through vaccination. Dentists are well-positioned to play a critical role in the prevention of oral cancer. We are often the first healthcare professionals to detect signs of oral cancer during routine dental exams. However, due to the nature of cancers located in the back of the mouth and throat, they often go unnoticed in their early stages. As you can imagine, delays in diagnosis lead to more invasive surgeries and decrease a person's chance of survival. By giving dentists the authority to prescribe and administer HPV vaccinations, we can prevent HPV-related oral cancers, reduce the number of Missourians who have to suffer from disfiguring treatment, and save lives in our state. Dentists are highly trained professionals who are very skilled in administering injections and providing preventive care. Our extensive training and education make us well-suited to play a critical role in helping to vaccinate the population against diseases related to oral health, and other infectious diseases during declared public health emergencies. Granting dentists this authority would increase access to vaccinations for those living in rural areas and other underserved communities, and address disparities in access to preventive care. Many individuals already seek preventive care from dentists and being able to receive vaccinations during a routine dental visit would make it easier for people to protect themselves against vaccine-preventable diseases, like HPV-related oral cancer. Overall, I believe this bill would be a positive step forward for public health in Missouri. I urge you to vote in favor of HB 249 as an important step to increase access to preventive care and help keep our communities healthy and safe. Thank you for your consideration. 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**TESTIMONY** HB-249 March 8, 2023 I am Dr. Michael McCuniff, retired Professor Emeritus from University of Missouri Kansas City School of Dentistry. My background/training and specialty degree is in Dental Public Health. Thank you for the privilege to testify in support of HB-249 which would allow dentists in the state of Missouri to administer Human Papilloma-Virus Vaccine or HPV vaccine (Gardasil 9 by Merck) which PREVENTs oropharyngeal carcinoma or throat cancer. HPV can cause genital warts and cancers of the mouth, throat, genitals and cervix. 79 million people are affected and 14 million new cases occur each year. There is no cure for infected people, only treatment for related health problems. In the state of Missouri only 53.2%(US:61.4%) of females and 53.9% (US: 56.0% of males between the ages of 13-17 are vaccinated which is below the national average. As a dentist and dental specialist in Dental Public Health, I am advocating for the dentists to administer the HPV vaccine. According to the CDC over 9000 individuals are diagnosed with HPV cancer of the mouth/throat and head/neck each year. All other types of oral cancer are decreasing except this one, which is increasing. Dentists can help to reduce the prevalence of HPV and HPV associated deaths. The American Dental Association is the governing body for over 201,927 dentists in the United States. The ADA advocates and supports dentists giving the vaccine and is campaigning for greater public education and health awareness of the threat of HPV. (ADA.org) Relating to dental workforce: In the state of Missouri there are approximately 4000 practicing dentists. Dentists give hundreds of thousands of injections daily in the mouth, with long and short needles, skillfully done around vital nerves and blood vessels. Of the entire healthcare team dentists give more injections daily than any other healthcare professionals but yet we have been prohibited and limited in practice scope to give an intramuscular shot in the deltoid muscle in the state of Missouri. Dentists and dental specialists currently put patients to sleep safely using potent medication in order to do complex surgical procedures but yet we have been prohibited or limited in practice scope to give an intramuscular shot in the deltoid muscle in the state of Missouri. Dentist and dental specialists repair broken jaws, fractured faces, sinus lifts, jaw joint surgeries and other complex surgeries of the head and mouth but yet we are prohibited or limited in practice scope to give an intramuscular shot in the deltoid muscle in the state of Missouri. Pharmacy techs can give injections with only a high school diploma or GED, an “understanding” of state-specific legislation surrounding the safe use and dispensing of medicines to patients” and a limited number of training hours administering injections. Continuous education is not required by the Missouri State Board of Pharmacy for these pharmacy technicians. Dentists play a vital role in the oral and systemic connection in controlling infections of the mouth which improve outcomes of major cardiac, joint replacement and cancer surgeries, not to mention healthier births and less preterm low weight babies, treatment of complex medical patients and practice of preventive healthcare such as diabetes management and tobacco cessation. Dentists and the medical professions hold shared responsibility over the multidisciplinary diagnosis and management of oropharyngeal

cancer, yet most dentists lack practice authority to deliver HPV vaccines. Dentists can prescribe schedule 2 - 5 controlled drugs. Dentists have a minimum of 8 years of education/training and a specialist can have up to 16 years of education/training. Dentists are also required to have 25 continuing education hours annually in the state of Missouri. Three states allow dentists to administer the HPV vaccine and 43 states allow them to give COVID-19 vaccines. HPV immunization reasonably falls within the scope of dental practice. Supporting this bill will help halt the rising number of people with HPV associated cancers of the mouth, throat and head and neck. Working together will help increase the low HPV vaccination rates in Missouri and save lives. As I have learned during my tenure in health care, you don't always want to be first to jump on the bandwagon, but you definitely don't want to be last....Missouri is getting close to the end by not allowing dentists to increase access to those in need of this vaccination.
