I'm 72 years old. Twice in my lifetime I've been in a situation where a firearm potentially prevented being attacked or fatally harmed. Neither situation was reported to police, and both of them took place in southern Illinois. When I was a young man, I returned to my vehicle from hunting. A car was stopped near mine. I saw that a man had a door open and had his body and one leg in my car. At gunpoint, I commanded him to back out of my car. As he backed out I saw that he had a sawed-off shotgun. Because I was armed, I was able to remain in control and that situation ended without anyone being harmed. On another occasion when I had a young family, we experienced an attempted home invasion. The man was drunk and at the wrong house, but he was trying to knock down our door. The door partially opened but the safety chain caught, and I commanded that he stop. I could only assume the worst, but I was able to take control without firing my weapon. So, in both cases I was able to prevent what could have turned into life threatening situations, but I could do so only because of my possession of a firearm and my preparation to defend myself and my family. Yes, the drunk turned out to be unarmed, but it could have been a drunk with a weapon, or a drunk with far more strength than me. The guy with the cutoff shotgun, well it was loaded and there is no telling where that may have gone. In neither case was law enforcement anywhere nearby. I lived in the St. Louis metro area over 40 years. There were many times when I felt unsafe on public transportation, especially on Metrolink. When the reported attacks on that system became too commonplace, I quit using the Metro. I have not needed to ever discharge my firearm because of the illegal actions of others. However, having the option to protect myself with a firearm has prevented twice situations from escalating. Because of the number of criminals running around with illegal firearms, I feel it essential to be defensive rather than submit myself as a potential target with no defense. It is my hope that the Missouri laws will soon permit law abiding citizens to legally carry concealed on all public transportation, including trains, busses, taxi's, or any vehicle transporting the person for hire.

My name is Corbett Sova and I am the Membership Officer of the Arnold Rifle and Pistol Club, in Jefferson County. I would like to thank the Committee for the opportunity to speak to you today on behalf of myself, our club and its 1,400-plus members. I am here tonight to ask that you support House Bill 282 to allow law abiding citizen with concealed carry permits to carry a concealed firearm on public transportation for self-protection. Just because someone needs or chooses to ride a bus or light rail to get to work, does not mean they should give up the right to defend themselves against criminals. I am excited to say I no longer must work in an office in an unsafe city. However, in the years leading up to becoming a remote employee I did work in downtown St Louis. If you saw the video of the homeless man being executed in broad daylight, that was a block from what used to be my office windows. At times I would get into work before the sun came up or leave after it went down. I never considered using our public transportation, because it meant walking multiple blocks in areas I would deem risky and doing so in an unprotected state due to current laws surrounding concealed carry on public transit. When my wife & I first started dating, she would take the Metrolink from work to her car, knowing that she had to keep her head down, make no eye contact, and not use her phone for fear of it being stolen. I started driving to her office to pick her up and drive her home, over concerns for her safety. We know that criminals don't care what the law says. They will come aboard the bus or train with a gun, and unlike the other riders who are just trying to get to work and provide for their families, the criminals are often on that bus or train for nefarious reasons. This situation leads to a total lack of confidence in the system. People are legitimately afraid to take public transportation in our state. As I mentioned earlier, if leaving our downtown St Louis office after dark I would offer to drive my co-workers to their vehicles for their own safety even if this meant going well out of my way. Current laws have created soft areas where criminals know they will find "easy pickings" – people who are unarmed and defenseless. It's time for that to change. Please vote to Do Pass on this important of legislation. Please don't let these bills die like their counterparts in recent years. Good evening. Thank you, Chairman Hardwick and the Committee for allowing me to share my testimony with you today. My name is Mark Buckner and I live in unincorporated Arnold, in northern Jefferson County. I am here again tonight to express my strong support for House Bill 282. Thank you, Representative Schnelting, for – again – sponsoring this important bill. It is past time that we enact legislation to allow lawful citizens to possess the means to defend themselves when riding on, or waiting on, public transportation in Missouri. I mention that I am here AGAIN because this legislation has been introduced repeatedly over the last several years, only to die at the end of session, having been squeezed out by budget matters. I am here tonight to urge you not to just pass this out of committee, but to actively work to move it through the legislative process and get it passed this year. Criminals, by definition, have no regard for laws, so they carry guns on busses and trains despite laws prohibiting this. Riders continue to be robbed, beaten, sexually assaulted, and even murdered on busses and light rail on a seemingly endless basis. Even Bi-State President and CEO Taulby Roach admitted in a January 2021 op-ed in the St. Louis Post-Dispatch that “It is no secret that our Metro Transit enterprise faced real and perceived security issues for the past several years.” That was 2021, and nothing has improved. Less than a week after he made that statement, and just over two years ago now, James Cook, a 30 year old Marine veteran, trying to provide for his wife and two small children by working as a security guard for Bi-State, was brutally murdered by a criminal who disregarded the law and carried a gun onto the MetroLink. However, pursuant to Missouri law, Mr. Cook was defenseless, prohibited from being armed to protect himself. January 31st is a terrible anniversary, but we must remember James Cook, and every other citizen, before and since, brutalized after being left unable to defend themselves on public transit in Missouri. Assaults and property crime on public transportation across the state have become so commonplace that local media outlets seldom even report it anymore. Some of these criminals are so bold that they have posted video of their crimes to social media. Why are they so audacious? Because they know they can operate on our busses and trains with total impunity because these vehicles are essentially mobile Gun-Free Zones, occupied by potential victims denied the ability to defend themselves. Make no mistake, criminals know this and exploit it to their advantage. The crime extends beyond the vehicles to the bus stops and train platforms, where criminals know their victims will be unarmed as they wait for their ride. It was on just such a train platform where Security Officer Cook was fatally shot in the face. It is safe to assume that the majority of those who rely on public transportation are economically disadvantaged to some extent and who can least afford to be robbed of what little they might have, or to afford the missed work and medical bills associated with being assaulted. The current state of the law prevents those most in need of protection from being able to defend themselves. This must change. The ability to defend oneself is one of our most basic rights, and that right should not be denied simply because one chooses, or is required by their circumstances, to use public transportation. I urge you to vote Do Pass on House Bill

282, and work with Speaker Plocher to get it placed on the House Calendar so it can finally be passed in this session. Thank you, Mark Buckner 2016 San Pedro Dr. Arnold, MO 63010-4161

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Hello my name is Robert Mills and I have lived in the Independence and Kansas City area for the past 24 years. I have also lived in other large metros (Chicago 3 years, New York City 5 years). I presently have my own vehicle, but relied on public transit for appx 10 years of my workday commutes. During those years I had multiple attempts to rob me, and have faced not just verbal threats, but also physical means of attacks upon me. I have always resisted, fought back, and never given up any property. In these several attacks, I have faced various weapons utilized by these thugs. From a sharpened screwdriver, to box-cutting knives, and have taken some powerful head blows from fists. In almost every attack I was outnumbered by 3 or more attackers. Only once did I face a solo attacker. We call criminals 'cowardly', but mainly I recognize they are animalistic predators and doing what animals do in utilizing superior numbers. I always remained resolved to fight back, but I recognize that I have been lucky to not have suffered a fatal or disabling injury. The monstrous dynamic of every one of these situations was this: the criminal predators absolutely bring as much weaponry to these attacks as they desire, yet I and my fellow regular law-abiding commuter types are required by law to be disarmed in the public transit areas. I have the right to carry concealed firearms nearly everywhere else in my daily routes, but the asinine and unconscionable state of affairs in our State and City Laws remains that these effective self-defense tools are STILL prohibited to us when riding public transit or in a transit facility. According to multiple studies there is no better means for a person to resist an attack than when they used a firearm. With regards to rape, the Dept of Justice/Bureau of Justice found of all means of defending against a rape attack (yelling/screaming, pepper spray, alarms, using fists or kicks, knives, or using a firearm) the firearm was by far the most successful means in both criteria: 1. Least likelihood for the victim to sustain injury, and 2. Least likelihood of rape attack to succeed. I have been that person working a nightshift requiring me to stand at a bus stop or train platform in very isolated moments, so I consider myself blessed these days to have my own vehicle to commute. But I still feel empathy for those I see at a bus stop or transit hub and knowing they are dealt with under our Missouri laws as subjects, persons not allowed to have the most effective means of self defense on their person. This is a terrible and unequal situation that has persisted for decades. We must not treat public transit riders as lesser humans, unworthy of full rights. 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Royce Barondes, Comments on HB 282 Although by profession I teach law, I have never engaged in the private practice of law in Missouri, and I am not engaged in the private practice of law. I am forwarding these comments in my individual capacity. I do not purport to speak for my employer or anyone else. With some trepidation, I support the bill. However, it could be substantially improved, both to correct drafting miscues and to address unfounded preferential treatment for former judges and current and former State legislators. In sum: 1. The bill commendably corrects drafting glitches in current law as to treatment of permits issued under 571.205.2. The bill's decriminalization of firearms possession on busses by permit holders is desirable. Criticisms often posed, stating firearms should be limited to police officers are often misleading, because: a. they often reference the training for specialized forces but do not reference the skills that ordinary police officers and security personnel have (and those persons are currently exempt); and b. The criticism's falsity is belied by those critics' failure to urge civilian possession where civilians meet the minimum on firearms tests for ordinary police officers or security personnel; and c. Current law curtails individual possession in contexts that Justice Alito has recently suggested implicate constitutional rights. 3. The bill, however, provides unwarranted special status to retired judges and current and retired legislators. They acquire certain rights possessed by holders of permits, but those rights are not subject to termination on misconduct grounds, whereas misconduct can result in a permit revocation for an ordinary person. 4. There are assorted drafting miscues in the bill that should be fixed. Those include that the bill leaves in place unexpected prohibitions on firearms possession in private bus terminals. In detail: 1. The bill makes corrections that I have previously supported that fix potential drafting glitches in the way current law treats permits issued under 571.205. See, e.g., proposed revised 571.030, line 102. Those ministerial changes are desirable, and the legislature should in any event fix those provisions. It is not clear to me that the same reference is required to be added in proposed 571.107 lines 2 and 7 and 130, because treatment of extended and lifetime permits as to these matters is included in 571.215. (These statutory provisions are immensely complicated, and I acknowledge that there may be a reason that is not apparent to myself.) 2. Possession on Busses The core of the bill is to decriminalize firearms possession in busses, with revisions proposed to chapters 70 and 577. In the past, some have suggested that this revision should be rejected because ordinary members of the public are not as trained as some specialized law enforcement personnel. Such a view is both misleading and in tension with a recent opinion by Justice Alito of the Supreme Court. a. Under 577.703.4 of current law, it constitutes the crime of possession and concealment of a dangerous or deadly weapon upon a bus to engage in that conduct. Current law excludes all law enforcement officers and commercial security personnel "who are in possession of weapons used within the course and scope of their employment". Note that this states the weapon be used in the scope of employment, it does not state that the individual is in the scope of employment when on the bus. It does not, by its literal terms, prohibit

possession of these weapons when the individual is not working, e.g., when commuting. The above-referenced criticism is misleading because the literal terms of this statute do not restrict firearms possession on busses to individuals subject to some higher training beyond ordinary police officers or ordinary commercial security personnel (an undefined term). Anyone who passes the minimum qualifications for those roles can possess a firearm, as long as the arm is "used within the course and scope of their employment." It is also misleading for anyone to support rejecting the amendment unless he or she also supports the amendment were it limited to allow possession by a permit holder who meets the minimum firearms proficiency test applicable to either of a general law enforcement officer or commercial security personnel. It is also misleading because often firearms are used defensively without having to be discharged. The mere presence of the arm is enough to prevent further victim status. b. in NYSRPA v. Bruen, Justice Alito in concurring noted, "Ordinary citizens frequently use firearms to protect themselves from criminal attack. According to survey data, defensive firearm use occurs up to 2.5 million times per year." New York State Rifle & Pistol Ass'n, Inc. v. Bruen, 142 S. Ct. 2111, 2158–59 (2022) (Alito, J., concurring). Preventing firearms possession on busses will result in disarmament throughout the day of persons who have to travel by bus to work. Justice Alito, concurring in Bruen, highlighted the plight of disarmed persons, who include in Missouri those who need to travel by bus and face the circumstances of persons in New York that Justice Alito discusses: "The police cannot disarm every person who acquires a gun for use in criminal activity; nor can they provide bodyguard protection for the State's nearly 20 million residents or the 8.8 million people who live in New York City. Some of these people live in high-crime neighborhoods. Some must traverse dark and dangerous streets in order to reach their homes after work or other evening activities. Some are members of groups whose members feel especially vulnerable. And some of these people reasonably believe that unless they can brandish or, if necessary, use a handgun in the case of attack, they may be murdered, raped, or suffer some other serious injury." Bruen, 142 S. Ct. at 2158 (Alito, J., concurring).

3. Unwarranted special treatment for retired judges and current and former members of the general assembly The bill in part endeavors to treat a retired judge or a current or former member of the general assembly as accreting to rights that an ordinary member of the public can get only by getting a firearms permit. See proposed 571.030.2, lines 57-59. I am not aware of a good reason why such a person ought to be entitled to special treatment, obviating the need to pay the fees paid by members of the public. This reeks of unwarranted favoritism. Moreover, the rights accruing to a holder of a permit are revocable in a variety of contexts. Those include the individual "is reasonably believed by the sheriff to be a danger to self or others based on previous, documented pattern." RSMo. 571.117, eighth check-box. The special rights in the proposed language for these individuals are not subject to termination for the same reason. No good reason exists why legislators (current or former) or former judges can have the benefits of having a permit after having engaged in acts that result in ordinary residents losing their ability to retain permits. The impact of this provision is somewhat mitigated, although not in a thoughtful way, by a drafting miscue. Holders of permits are exempt from local restrictions on carrying a firearm openly. RSMo. 21.750.3(2). A core benefit of this provision arises from the fact that it protects from criminalization under local law concealed carry where an arm is temporarily visible, e.g., from a wind gust. This provision makes practicable the exercise of rights a permit affords. These legislators and judges do not benefit from that preemption—they are not mentioned in 21.750. And, because the preemption contemplates that a permit holder would show a permit on demand, having it apply to legislators is not straightforward.

4. Assorted drafting miscues. Section 577.712 is proposed to be amended. The amendment adds "Except as otherwise provided by section 571.107," in line 12, p.31, of the bill. I gather the intended cross-reference is to a new 571.107.3, which would allow possession of firearms on or about one's person on certain publicly-funded transportation systems. The problem is that the exception does not apply to busses and associated terminals that are not "publicly-funded". I am unaware of a reason why the legislature intends to make privately-owned public busses and associated terminals subject to treatment atypical of private property. In the ordinary case, possession of a firearm by a permit holder is not a weapons crime, even if the property is posted (although I gather it could be a trespass). See RSMo. 571.030.4 (traditional permits). Unless the legislature intends to continue criminalization as a weapons offense of permit holders' firearms possession on private bus property, including terminals, then 577.712.2 needs an additional exception that parallels the exception added in proposed 577.703.4(3), lines 24-26 (as proposed to be revised, below).

b. Omission of out-of-State permit holders in proposed 577.703.4(3), lines 24-26. In assorted locations, Missouri firearms law seeks to treat non-residents holding out-of-State permits as it treats residents with Missouri permits. See RSMo. 571.107.1. It does that by adding reference to those non-residents with out-of-State permits. It is not clear why the parallel language for holders of out-of-State permits has been excluded in the proposal. This language appears to give rise to a trap for the unwary. Corresponding reference to holders of out-of-State permits also is omitted in existing RSMo. 571.107.2 (in language that appears in lines 128-132 of the bill). That seems unexpected because the language introducing the 17 locations in 571.107 makes reference to holders of out-of-

State permits. See lines 3-4 of 571.107 in the bill. That would appear to be a typographical error in 571.107.2, sentence 1. Otherwise, there may be an unexpected, negative treatment for non-residents, and those persons (unless in the military) cannot be issued Missouri permits. See proposed 571.107, lines 20-31, 571.205, lines 22-26. Adjustments necessary as to the consequences, for holders of out-of-State permits, of remaining after having been asked to leave, are something current law does not address. 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Chairman Hardwick and Members of the Committee, On behalf of the members of the National Rifle Association in Missouri, I would like to express our strong support for House Bill 282 and our thanks to Representative Schnelting for his leadership on this issue. This legislation has been a priority for the NRA for a number of sessions and I believe this is the year we can get it across the finish line. HB 282 would remove the prohibition on law abiding concealed carry permit holders from exercising their fundamental right to self-defense while using publicly funded transportation systems. Missourians across the state utilize public transportation for a variety of reasons such as getting to and from work, visiting friends or family or simply running errands. I'd like to address one of the arguments coming from the opponents of this bill. They claim that if HB 282 becomes law, that it could jeopardize state and federal funding for services like OATS, SMTS and other rural transportation providers who have contracts to operate in the state. I have not seen any supporting information from them to substantiate these claims so I did some digging of my own. First, on both OATS and SMTS's website, there is no mention in their Rules of Conduct and Safety Policies that these companies prohibit weapons or firearms on their vehicles. I would think if their funding through grants is contingent on firearms being prohibited aboard their busses that their codes of conduct and policies would reflect that. Second, Missouri Statute provides that funds are administered by the Missouri State Transit Assistance Program, and subject to rules established by the Missouri highways and transportation commission. That statute reads in part: "Any rule or portion of a rule that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028." That last section, Mo. Stat. 536.028, requires that rules cannot conflict with state law. The opponents argue that "various Missouri state departments' have their own regulations for transportation service that would conflict with any concealed carry weapon bill passed." As I just noted, though, any rules that these state entities pass still have to comply with state law – and a state law allowing concealed carry by permit holders means that it is the conflicting rule that must give way. Last but not least, I'll touch on the Federal Funding and grants. I've reviewed the Federal Transit Administration's Master Agreement that applies to all financial aid, whether a Grant Agreement, Cooperative Agreement, Loan Agreement, Loan Guarantee Agreement, or Line of Credit Agreement financed with federal funds. The object of this 104 page document is to set out the "standard terms and conditions." Nowhere in that document, revised as recently as February 2022, does the word firearm or weapon appear. In closing, this bill repeals an arbitrary "gun-free zone" that does nothing to hinder criminals while leaving law-abiding citizens defenseless, and ensure that citizens with varying commutes throughout their day, and of various economic means, are able to exercise their Second Amendment rights and defend themselves. Thank you for the opportunity to

provide testimony in support of HB 282 and I strongly urge you to support this legislation.

Every year more than 11 million people of all ages and backgrounds step aboard public transit in the bi-state area. Concealed carry is not a reasonable assumption in a transit environment, just like it isn't reasonable at stadiums or in any massive crowd situation. House Bill 282 would end the prohibition of concealed guns on mass transit systems. The introduction of uncontrolled presence of firearms on the RideKC Public Transit system is not recommended. The KCATA is a governmental body promulgated by a Bi-State compact between Kansas and Missouri, and we have a right and obligation to protect our employees and riders from harm by excluding firearms. There should be no difference in public transportation modes such as aircraft, buses and trains. Weapons should not be on any of these modes unless the carrier is a peace officer.
