As a parent of three children and as someone who works in higher education and is completing a doctorate in education, I believe strongly that school choice empowers students to escape failing schools and is morally just. I watched a friend of mine lease apartments in better school districts and drive her three children to different schools to meet their educational needs because she lived in the Kansas City, MO school district. She is a Black business owner and single parent, but she jumped through remarkable hoops to give her children the education she felt they needed. As a former public school teacher, my experience in K-12 education and higher education confirmed that I wanted something better for my children. I worked in an affluent district teaching English but still found many of my students unable read at grade level, and their writing was such that they would likely have to take remedial instruction upon entering college. Writing isn't truly measured on end of course exams, you see, and as such, is pushed aside until teachers are no longer under the threat of exams. I currently teach college students learning strategies, helping to fill the gaps that their high school education left. These students come from a variety of backgrounds in wealthy and poor schools, with and without learning disabilities and language barriers. I want something more for my sons: I want them to love learning, to be challenged and to be prepared for college if that is what they choose to do. I work part time as an adjunct so the extra support of programs like MO-Scholars enables us to make this choice. I firmly believe it should not be something that is only for the well informed and that its reach should be such that all families can make the same choice if they desire. If we learned anything from the pandemic, it should be that schooling is on a precipice of change. Let's make that change one that remedies some of the inequity in the system.

Hello, My name is Chris Vas and I am the Scholarship Director for the Herzog Tomorrow Foundation. The Herzog Tomorrow Foundation is based in Smithville, Missouri and we are one of the 6 EAO's working with the MOScholars program. I am not here to support or oppose this legislation, but wanted to provide some information about the impact that we have seen in just the first 6 months of this lifechanging ESA program. From July-December, the Herzog Tomorrow Foundation was able to raise \$3.1M in tax-credits from 165 donors. We were able to turn those tax-credit donations around and fund 604 scholarships to students and families attending one of our 85+ secular and religious partner schools. Of those students, 122, or 20% were students with IEP's. 358 students, or 60% of our students qualified with an IEP, or were below the 100% income level of free and reduced school lunch. These 604 students were able to achieve their educational dreams. We hope to expand our impact to 720 students in year two of this program. These students are enrolling in a a private school or out-of-district public school because their in-district option was not meeting their needs. Our families have a very high satisfaction level with their new educational option. This is evidenced by a 97.5% renewal rate for year two by our current families. We are participating in the program to help students. We believe that students deserve every chance at a quality education. Our state also benefits from these positive outcomes. Currently, public schools receive more funding for students that require a little bit more help to learn. This legislation would extend those same metrics to our students participating in the MOScholars program. ESA's have offered a lifeline to families across the state, and our hope is that the General Assembly continues to support expanded educational opportunities for all Missouri children.
