HB 1150 was the original bill back in 2011-12, has created far more problems and elevated auto theft significantly since its passage in 2012. I would encourage the committee to change the law from 10 to 20 years. There are a bunch of changes I would like to see, but this is the biggest problem for auto theft. It essentially allows an individual to sell a vehicle ten years old or older to a shredder. The vehicle has to be "inoperable" but their definition of inoperable is ludicrous. If I remove a wheel...the vehicle is inoperable. What's happened in response to this law, is they take anything and everything to the shredder...once it's shredded, it is unidentifiable.Opposition might say police aren't doing their jobs, it's stealing. I would contend many recycling centers are also not doing their jobs as it's illegal to "receive stolen property."
