HJR-18, - 24, -25, -28, -29, -30 and -43 and HB-391, -703 and -780 are not in the best interests of our democracy. The process which already exists requires a high thresh hold of signatures and has served us well. A two-thirds majority on any ballot decision or election is unrealistic.
