Additionally, as businesses work to meet customer needs, overcome supply chain issues, and deal with inflationary challenges, the business community would benefit from additional opportunities to strengthen employer access to trained workers to support business growth.HB 417 provides this opportunity by creating a grant program that will allow employers to support the upskilling of current or prospective employees.
