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Aligned supports HB 558 as the framework to evaluate the performance of districts, schools, and charter schools in meaningful ways and to direct resources to the lowest performing in order to raise student achievement. Specifically, Aligned would like to highlight these provisions: metrics that are specific to school level, the emphasis on growth, and the supports provided for school turnaround. In HB 558, metrics for K-8 schools emphasize year-over-year growth and achievement; for high schools, college and career readiness indicators are the primary focus. Numerous variables can affect student performance, and focusing on growth recognizes the extent to which students, schools, school districts, and charter schools. In HB 558, year-over-year progress of students toward a set standard will be included, as well as the measurement of the "value add" of the school or LEA. Supports for school turnaroundDESE is required to include funds to improve persistently underachieving schools and LEAs in their annual budget requests. HB 558 sets reasonable parameters and high expectations for Missouri's students and schools.
