Written statement from Joev Smith. Vice President & Chief Information Security Officer of Schnuck Markets, Inc.Cyber crime continues to be on the rise and making headlines every day. As companies have become increasingly digitally connected it has become significantly more important to have modern and updated cyber security technologies in place to reduce the risk of a data breach. In my 18 years in the Cyber Security industry, sadly, I have witnessed countless companies fall victim to successful data breach attacks. The harm caused by these breaches is not just incurred by the organization victimized by these crimes, but also for the organization's customers. These customers are everyday citizens who should feel that their data is safe and protected wherever it is that they choose to do business. Unfortunately, we hear time and again of networks and services being shut down, identities being stolen, fraudulent charges incurring on a payment card or even bank accounts being drained as a result of a successful breach event. I provide this statement in support of House Bill number 668 to simply testify that many of the breaches that lead to such devastation could have been prevented if the victimized company had possessed even some of the most basic security controls. A few examples of these controls are, network segmentation, identity and access management, patching, encryption, two-factor authentication, and internal security awareness training. These examples are on a short list of controls we know significantly reduce the risk of a successful cyber attack. However, procuring, deploying, and managing these technologies comes at a cost to organizations and businesses. I support this bill because it will alleviate some of the financial burden to procure such cyber security protections for Missouri businesses. As a Missourian, I am proud to see my state put this bill forward for consideration and it is my hope to see other states follow in Missouri's lead. For these reasons, I am in support of House Bill number 668 (Houx). Bio: Joey Smith is the Vice President and Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) for Schnuck Markets, Inc. Smith joined the company as their first named CISO in January 2014 and is responsible for enhancing the security program of the company. Since joining, he has created and implemented a comprehensive risk based security strategy for the company. This has included bringing in the people, processes, and technologies needed to maintain a mature security posture. Previous to Schnucks, Smith worked for MasterCard Worldwide running the technology company's incident response program. From 2008 - 2012, he was the primary investigator and incident manager for MasterCard's global Incident Response team. In 2012, he joined the MasterCard Account Data Compromise team. In this role, he was responsible for fraud investigations and worked closely with merchants, issuers, acquirers and other payment card brands to issue fraud alerts and respond to global breach events. He was also part of the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Security Standards Council responsible for reviewing the work of the various PCI forensic investigation companies to ensure the work being performed met the guality standards of the PCI Council.

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As cybersecurity threats continue to increase it is critical that all companies, schools and public entities have processes in place to identify, protect, detect, respond, and recover as put forth in the National Institute of Standards and Technology - Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity. I would suggest increasing the limit for each grant application as \$15,000 is minimal to make positive enhancements and implementations. Recent Missouri State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program had a maximum allowable amount of \$200,000. The reserve for 50% to employers of 50 or less is a great benefit as long as the information gets out and published to make the group aware of the opportunity.
