That is at the rate of only five cents per minute. Totalling that to an amount of nine hundred a month. I am fearful that this bill will encourage the DOC to raise the rates and that will hinder contact with so many incarcerated people and their support. My children need contact with thier dad and I need contact with my husband. The cost of living both inside and outside of the DOC is so high that I can't imagine having to find a way to pay for a possible rate of twelve cents per minute for calls. Please take the greedy DOC thought process into consideration when viewing this bill. Families struggle enough as it is with incarceration. It's detrimental from every standpoint.
