On behalf of the members of the Freedom Principle MO, we offer our support for the following bills: HB 366, HB205, HB262, HB 445, and HB 700. The ongoing release of emerging data from experts in the medical field regarding the harmful and often deadly side effects related to COVID-19 shots and boosters is of immediate concern to Missourians as a matter of health and safety. February 22, 2023Re; Opposition to House Bill 700Dear Chair Hardwick, Vice-Chair Diehl, and members of the Committee: Thank you for the opportunity to comment in opposition to House Bill 700, which would weaken the ability of Missouri public health officials to continue protective vaccination policies. The mission of The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) is to cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease, and myeloma and improve the quality of life for the more than 1.3 million people in the United States living with blood cancer, and their families. LLS urges you to oppose House Bill 700 because it would undermine evidence-based, public health vaccine requirement policies that support the wellbeing of those facing cancer. At LLS, our top priority is the safety of blood cancer patients and survivors. We know they are at increased risk of severe illness and death from COVID-19. However, LLS' research shows that as many as 1 in 4 blood cancer patients may not be able to mount the same robust antibody response as healthy individuals after being vaccinated against COVID-19, making it even more important for those around them in healthcare and educational settings to be vaccinated. Further, higher vaccination rates mean lower hospitalization rates. That reduces strain on our health care system and helps to ensure that hospitals can care for patients with other emergencies outside of those related to preventable communicable diseases. No patient with a serious or chronic health condition such as a blood cancer should be forced to delay, avoid, or abandon treatment or care because our health system has been overwhelmed by cases that could have been largely avoided through vaccination. We all must do our part to ensure our actions keep the most vulnerable around us safe, including adults and children fighting cancer. As such, we respectfully urge your committee to protect immunocompromised cancer patients by opposing this effort to diminish proven public health strategies like vaccine requirements. On behalf of the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) and those we serve, I am writing to share concerns regarding language that would impact the operations of the American Cancer Society and our important work in Missouri. Currently, legislation before the House Emerging Issues committee includes language regarding the ability of Missouri entities to require COVID-19 vaccination. Due to the multiple versions of language that have been considered around this issue, we wanted to share with the committee information regarding the impact this language could have on cancer patients and the American Cancer Society. As part of its mission to ease the burden of cancer, the American Cancer Society operates services for cancer patients, including rides to cancer treatment and two Hope Lodge facilities in Missouri. Hope Lodges allow the American Cancer Society to continue to ease the financial burden of cancer treatment for patients and caregivers who need a place to stay while receiving their cancer treatment in St. Louis and Kansas City. The Kansas City facility alone provided 3,721 patients and caregivers with 11,128 nights of free lodging in 2019. Many cancer patients and their families have been hard hit by the COVID-19 pandemic which has placed cancer patients at substantial risk for severe illness. Cancer treatments – from chemotherapy to immunotherapy to bone marrow transplants - often weaken a patient's immune system, making cancer patients especially vulnerable to communicable illnesses like COVID-19. Many of the cancer patients who make use of American Cancer Society services are immunocompromised. The health and safety of people with cancer as well as our staff is our top priority. In order to protect our constituents who are at high risk for the most serious outcomes from COVID-19, the American Cancer Society and ACS CAN are requiring vaccines for all staff, including those who serve Hope Lodge guests, as well as volunteers who interact with cancer patients in our Road to Recovery patient transportation program. Language that prohibits the American Cancer Society from including COVID-19 vaccination in its safety protocols would impact its ability to serve patients in their fight against cancer. I would welcome the opportunity to further discuss our concerns with committee members, your staff, or colleagues.
