Attracting, recruiting and retaining a skilled workforce remains one of the top barriers to business growth and success in the state. As employers seek qualified workers, a large untapped pool of workers includes justice-involved individuals. The Springfield Chamber supports addressing workforce barriers by growing the pool of accessible and quality workers. However, there are always certain risks in hiring any individual, including those who have been previously incarcerated. This bill would provide liability protections for employers who have hired those who have been convicted of certain offenses. This will encourage employers who are desperate for workers to consider employment for justice-involved individuals who have significant skills to offer. Ultimately, this legislation will further the goal of reducing recidivism rates with stable employment opportunities and community involvement. The passage of this bill is an important step in the right direction for protecting employers as we look for innovative approaches to growing our state's workforce pool and we encourage your support.
