To the Missouri House Election and Elected Officials Committee: The Missouri Sierra Club supports House Bill 781. The Missouri Sierra Club represents over 8,000 dues-paying members across the state who advocate for conservation, environmental, social justice, and democracy through grassroots efforts. We believe that every voter should have all the tools to exert their constitutional right to be involved in our democracy.HB 781 repeals requirements that voters register a political party affiliation when registering to vote, or be marked unaffiliated, which we support as this allows voters to have more options to vote instead of only being able to vote in the party for which they are registered. Additionally, HB781 states that a government entity does not have to register with the Secretary of State to solicit voter registration, which is a positive policy change as this reduces the bureaucracy in simply assisting others with their constitutional right to vote. Currently, registering with the state was a part of HB 1878 that passed 2022, which is now being blocked in the courts. The Sierra Club is especially supportive of the measures outlined to protect local election authorities from harassment and intimidation. In 2022, the Brennan Center for Justice released a report which showed that 1 in 6 election officials have received threats for doing their jobs. We are concerned for the wellbeing and safety of our needed election authorities. By protecting election authorities, we can ensure that everyone is able to safely exercise their right to vote. The Sierra Club urges you to vote YES on HB 781.

HB 781 is positive voting rights legislation and should be voted DO PASS by this committee. First, it clarifies that government entities are not subject to the solicitation registration requirement of the Truly Agreed and Finally Passed version of House Bill 1878 that was signed into law by Gov. Parson in 2022. Voter registration should be encouraged in a healthy society, and we should all do what we can to see that our neighbors are invited to register and to vote. Secondly, HB 781 mandates that voters are not required to register by political party. Many Missourians have privacy concerns related to political affiliation and might be discouraged from participating in democracy when this added layer of party identification is required. Partisanship is destructive to a spirit of community, so we should minimize this in society. Finally, HB 781 makes it a class one election offense to disseminate personal information of an election official or their family with the intent to harass, intimidate, or influence the performance of their duties. Recent studies have shown that one in six election officials have received threats for doing their jobs, a very distressing development. We must do all that we can to protect local election authorities from harassment and intimidation. About Paraguad: Paraguad is one of the oldest and largest independent living centers in the country. ADL Heartland Testimony in Support of HB 781 On behalf of ADL Heartland, I appreciate the opportunity to express support of Missouri House Bill 781. Founded in 1913, ADL has had a timeless mission to "stop the defamation of the Jewish people and to secure justice and fair treatment for all." Our work in ensuring the protection of marginalized communities both online and in the real world is more relevant today than ever before. Unfortunately, we know that hate and extremism are on the rise, and digital spaces are not immune. According to a 2021 nationally representative ADL survey, 41% of Americans have experienced online hate and harassment, and 27% have experienced severe online harassment, which includes sexual harassment, stalking, physical threats, swatting, doxing and sustained harassment. Online hate continues to ruin lives by stoking fear, silencing voices and causing harm to people's physical and professional safety. One of the most common tactics of online harassment is doxing - meaning publicly sharing an individual's personal information with the intent that the information be used against the target for an unlawful purpose. These actions are a severe threat to our community—and when the victim is an election official—the act impacts the ability to carry out democracy as a whole. Unfortunately, our laws have not kept up with hate and harassment online. The penalties for such offenses must take into consideration the serious and lasting effects of online hate and harassment. Doxing against election officials must be codified into Missouri state law so we can protect targets and hold perpetrators accountable for their malicious and reckless actions. ADL urges this committee to support HB 781 to address doxing election officials in Missouri State law. If passed, this law will strengthen democracy by providing a clear prohibition against a tactic meant to deter participation in administering elections. We thank you for your time and consideration. This allows voters to voluntarily register with a political party that they most firmly agree in principles and support that party. Closed primaries allow those affiliating with a chosen political party to chose their political party members and their party's elected official candidates to run for their chosen office.Closed primaries allow those professing to share the principled beliefs of their chosen party to chose candidates for their own party without significant interference by those not believing in the party's stated beliefs and values. This would significantly prevent those not believing in the party's beliefs and values from interfering with the privilege to chose one's party candidates to represent the party members as candidates for political office. Why would say a professed party member want to have a candidate not aligned with the professed party values run for an office except for nefarious purposes. Is it right for a large number of non-party members to be able to choose the party's candidate. Would it be right for any citizen to come and sit in the Missouri House committee members' chairs during a hearing and vote in place of the elected representative. However, would it be right for the citizens of Missouri to all come and join the House session and have the ability to vote for their choice of House leaders and every House vote? I am sure you can imagine that we would not have the current leaders in either side of the Missouri legislature if we did! What if the voters all had the ability to vote for committee chairs and vice chairs? What if the voters had the ability to vote for and chose the members for each of the committees? Would it be right? We have elected representatives responsible for proposing and voting on bills and laws. Would the elected representatives in the Missouri House appreciate the freedom and ability of the voters to participate and vote in every House session on the floor and all committee hearings? As you can see, restricting (or in this case, starting to restrict or affiliate parties) to only those claiming to represent or actually elected to represent each voting unit or party is the only truly fair option. Why would the Missouri legislators choose to go backwards on improvements made to fully empower their citizens to elect their own representatives for political office like many other states already have. Why negate the progress already made. In fact, in order to be fully representative, Missouri should be establishing closed primaries. The political parties are actually private organizations which have to abide within the set of laws established. My name is Linda Rantz, I am a Republican Committeewoman in Osage County, I oppose HB 781. specifically the changes to 115.155 and 115.631, for the following reasons.1. 115.155: Repeal and Replacement of statutes related to optional designation of political party. The ability for voters to optionally declare their political party affiliation, passed last year in HB 1878, was a huge benefit insofar as the assistance it would provide to Election Authorities and political party committees in the task of recruiting and appointing Election Judges, Challengers, Watchers, and Deputies for elections. All of these positions are dependent on equal numbers of Democrats and Republicans (major political parties) and have traditionally been difficult to fill. I believe one primary cause of this has been the inability to know party affiliation of the voters. Who "Picks" the Election Judges? The law is very clear that the Clerk "designates" or "assigns" the Election Judges. But statute 115.087, for counties without a Board of Elections, states that the major political party committees in each county are supposed to submit a list of Election Judges to serve in the county's elections. What better way to ensure that Republican Election Judges are Republicans, and Democrat Election Judges are Democrats than to have their political parties submit their names? If the political parties do not provide the names of Election Judges, the responsibility goes back to the Clerk.Unfortunately, a county resident may be affiliated with one of the major parties, but choose not to be connected with their county committee. How, then, can the political parties reach voters in their county to encourage them to participate in the elections in one of the roles available to voters? As a result, several Clerks have told me that they do not get lists from the political committees. So, over many years, it seems the political parties have abdicated this task and the Election Authorities have just "assumed" the responsibility of recruiting citizens to serve as Election Judges. After all, in the long run, it is the Clerk's responsibility to make sure they have enough Election Judges from both major political parties for each election. The county committees are also supposed to submit a list of Challengers (115.105) and Watchers (115.107) for elections. These, again, are important positions for ensuring that both major political parties are actively involved in ensuring fairness of our elections. The importance of the work of Watchers and Challengers is not whether the election results are 'red', 'blue', or other, but that the election was fair and secure. If any political party fails to submit a list of Challengers and Watchers, or enough to cover all polling places, that party misses out on the chance to have Challengers and Watchers act on their behalf during elections. The Clerk does not fill these positions. Finally, a Clerk or Election Authority has the authority to appoint deputies to assist in conducting the election (115.053). Persons for these positions are NOT submitted by the political parties, but the Clerk is required to employ deputies in pairs, one Democrat and one Republican believe that voters who were willing to declare their political party affiliation would be more likely to agree to serve as Election Judges, Watchers, Challengers, and/or Deputies. Removing this provision from 115.155 will only continue to leave Election Authorities and County Committees scrambling to spend funds advertising in mass media, in an attempt to locate

willing Democrats and Republicans. Statute 115.155, as it is currently written, provides the Clerk and committees with a more targeted approach to filling these essential elections positions.2. 115.631: Intent to harass, intimidate, or influence election officials and their families oppose the proposed repeal and replacement of 115.631 for the following reasons. While I strongly object to the 'doxing' of anyone, which this bill seems to be addressing, I think there are First Amendment violations in the language, as written. None of the personal information listed in this bill is illegal to share or publish under other circumstances, as far as I know. To tie this to the "intent to harass, intimidate, influence such official in the performance of his or her duties" does not, in my opinion, give the State the ability to ignore First Amendment rights. Further, this language does not go far enough in protecting Missourians who serve in these roles from having the same personal information listed in this bill, stolen in a cybercrime from the Election Authority. What recourse does a citizen have if the County's computer system is hacked and personal data of the Election Judges, Challengers, Watchers, and Deputies is stolen? What if a third-party vendor engaged by the Election Authority is hacked? What are the protections against bad actors (be it a person or foreign nation) who use stolen personal information to bribe or blackmail Election Judges? What will those penalties be and how will they be imposed?HB 1878 added requirements for cyber security reviews of county systems every 2 years. Why? If our election systems are safe and secure, why do we need to check them every 2 years? If something could happen in 2 years, how do we know nothing has happened in voting systems that are older than 2 years? It has already happened in Missouri, and not just once. This link is from 2021 when the City of Joplin paid \$320,000 to "an unknown person" because of a ransomware attack.https://apnews.com/article/technology-business-health-coronavirus-pandemic-michael-brown-510ebc313dce8f3288c10a652a9998edl believe that the biggest threat to Election Judges, etc., and their families, is NOT from a person who doxes them. The biggest threat is from cyber thieves and others who do not need to dox someone to blackmail them or influence them in their election duties.If protection of Election Judges, etc., is the goal, we should bring in experts who can explain the real threat and write legislation that will protect Missourians who are willing to serve in our elections.

I have been involved with a number of initiative petition campaigns. I was not paid or compensated in any way. I stood outside in all kinds of weather because I believed in stopping predatory lending, raising the minimum wage, and expanding Medicaid. I resent the comment I often hear that people don't know what they are signing. I've had hundreds of conversations with people and provided ways they could get further information. Gathering signatures is not easy. These bills seek to add many unnecessary barriers to the process. I'm also disturbed that they want to require 2/3 of the vote to pass. This, as you well know, will make passage nearly impossible. How many legislatively proposed amendments do you believe would ever pass with that margin? Probably none. The initiative petition process has been enshrined in Missouri for decades. It is the way for people to speak when legislators willfully ignore the will of the people. I served as the local election authority in Phelps County from 2015-2022. I followed HB 1878 last year. which inserted the "party affiliation" language into RSMo Ch. 115, which this bill will eliminate. Because of the introduction of this bill, HB 781, I looked back and, after some study, concluded that perhaps HB 1878 was somewhat incomplete, in that it didn't seem to limit the number of times a voter could declare this affiliation, or any deadlines prior to elections for doing so. So, that seems a bit problematic. HB 1878 last year also very nearly eliminated the single statute making reference to the party caucuses in presidential election years, but RSMo 115.776 was restored before passage, while the statutes related to the presidential preference primary were eliminated (those others in Ch. 115 in the 700's). Without the caucus, which is the grassroots of the people who affiliate with the party designating their favored candidate through selection of CD and state convention delegates, the national conventions risk becoming a referendum of only the well-connected at the higher levels of the party. So, the caucus is important. Without party affiliation, however, the caucus outcomes risk the distortion that comes from cross-over voting. Cross-over voting between the two major parties is common, in my opinion. I recall multiple instances when my Democratic party poll judges would vote a Republican ballot, as walk-in absentee voters in the office. I made no comment when they did so; without statutory prohibition, I was not going to be the police matron. The reverse never happened; that is, Republican poll judges never, in my experience, requested a Democratic ballot. So we have primary elections, the outcome of which strictly limits the eligibility for the November ballot, in which there is cross-over voting. This is demoralizing to the extreme! It is my opinion that either there should be party affiliation which limits primary ballot choice, or ballot access for the general election needs to be more open. The caucuses leading up to the presidential-year national conventions will occur in early 2024. In its present form, HB 781 removes all mention of party affiliation within the voter record, prior to these caucuses being held. Cross-over voting or participation in party caucuses is a very real possibility. This bill also expands the list of first-class (felonies associated with the right of suffrage) election offenses. On page 11, lines 88-97, there is a "special class" of persons created and surely the list of offenses against election authorities and their families and property are already covered in other statutes. For my part, I did not feel threatened and did not seek any special protection. I made it plain in my 2014 campaign that everyone would be treated the same under the election laws.
