Missouri Sheriffs United and Sheriffs across Missouri want to go on record in opposition to SB378. We respect and support what Senator Rowden wants to accomplish. However, as it stands, SB378 contains language that is problematic. Any organization or professional association who pays a lobbyist is a "lobbyist principle." As written, SB378 will prevent an origination such as the Missouri Sheriffs' Association from:1) Awarding employees of sheriff's offices with commendations such as Deputy, Reserve Deputy, and Jail Administrator of the year as well as prohibit paying for their meals and lodging at an awards banquet. 2) Distributing funds from our Benevolent Fund to employees of a sheriff's office. 3) Sending plants and/or flowers to sick or injured employees of a sheriff's office.4) Providing any service, or thing of value to employees of a sheriff's office, (i.e. appreciation dinners, challenge coins, hotel rooms & lodging for attending or providing training) In addition to the devastating and unnecessary negative effect on organizations and associations, as worded, SB378 unfairly affects any employee of an elected official. For example: Mark Jones, a lobbyist, is getting married. Serval of Mark's friends are employees of the sheriff's office, the local police department, the prosecutor's office, and the county clerk's office. SB378 will prohibit Mark from providing his friends with food and beverages at the wedding. If they travel a fair distance, Mark could not provide them with lodging. If they were members of the wedding party, Mark could not provide them gifts for being a part of the wedding. Again, we respect and support what SB378 is trying to accomplish. However, we oppose its passage without working through issues such as I mentioned.

The current language of SB 378 could have the unintended consequence of preventing Vendor Expo's and trade shows for Annual Training Conferences. The Missouri County Collectors' Association, as well as the Missouri Association of Counties (MAC) and other affiliate Associations - County Auditors, County Recorders, etc. include Trade Expo's aka Vendor Shows as part of their Annual Training Conferences. The Vendors pay a fee to participate in these events. These fees help keep the cost of putting on Annual Training Conferences lower for the attendees and these vendors/businesses get to put their products in front of the people to whom they want to market. This is a win/win for the Associations and the Businesses. County Budgets are extremely tight and to put additional financial burden on them by eliminating the supplemental revenue to the various Office Associations could impact the ability of some office holders to attend their statutorily required trainings. I respectfully request you do not pass SB 378 out of Committee.
