Further amend said resolution, Page 3, Section 3(c), Line 8, by deleting the number "thirty" and inserting in lieu thereof the numbers "[thirty] thirty-one"; and
Further amend said resolution and page, Section B, Lines 5-11, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
"Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to pass constitutional amendments proposed by initiative or convention by a statewide majority vote and a majority vote in a majority of congressional districts?"."; and
