1 AMEND House Bill No. 2381, Page 3, Section 44.251, Line 80, by inserting after all of said section  
2 and line the following:

3 "571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful possession of a firearm if such  
4 person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:

5 (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state, or of a crime  
6 under the laws of any state or of the United States which, if committed within this state, would be a  
7 felony; [ø]

8 (2) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated or drugged  
9 condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent; or

10 (3) Such person is under eighteen years of age and is on public property. However,  
11 possession under this subdivision is not an offense if such person possesses the firearm:

12 (a) While accompanied by a person twenty-one years of age or older;

13 (b) For the purposes of a school-sanctioned, firearm-related event or club event;

14 (c) For the lawful pursuit of game; or

15 (d) As otherwise authorized by law.

16 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class D felony, unless a person has been convicted  
17 of a dangerous felony as defined in section 556.061, in which case it is a class C felony.

18 3. The provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section shall not apply to the  
19 possession of an antique firearm."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
22 accordingly.
