1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 1363, Page 20, Section 473.742, Line 84,
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "488.040. [1.] Each grand and petit juror shall~~], pursuant to the provisions of section~~
5 494.455, receive six dollars per day for every day he or she may actually serve as such and seven
6 cents for every mile he or she may necessarily travel going from his or her place of residence to the
7 courthouse and returning, to be paid from funds of the county or a city not within a county.

8 2. ~~Provided that a county or a city not within a county authorizes daily compensation~~
9 payable from county or city funds for jurors who serve in that county pursuant to subsection 3 of
10 this section in the amount of at least six dollars per day in addition to the amount required by
11 subsection 1 of this section, a person shall receive an additional six dollars per day, pursuant to the
12 provisions of section 494.455, to be reimbursed by the state of Missouri so that the total
13 compensation payable shall be at least eighteen dollars, plus mileage as indicated in subsection 1 of
14 this section, for each day that the person actually serves as a petit juror in a particular case; or for
15 each day that a person actually serves as a grand juror during a term of a grand jury. The state shall
16 reimburse the county for six dollars of the additional juror compensation provided by this
17 subsection.

18 3. ~~The governing body of each county or a city not within a county may authorize additional~~
19 daily compensation and mileage allowance for jurors, which additional compensation shall be paid
20 from the funds of the county or a city not within a county. The governing body of each county or a
21 city not within a county may authorize additional daily compensation and mileage allowance for
22 jurors attending a coroner's inquest. Jurors may receive the additional compensation and mileage
23 allowance authorized by this subsection only if the governing body of the county or the city not
24 within a county authorizes the additional compensation. The provisions of this subsection
25 authorizing additional compensation shall terminate upon the issuance of a mandate by the Missouri
26 supreme court which results in the state of Missouri being obligated or required to pay any such
27 additional compensation even if such additional compensation is formally approved or authorized
28 by the governing body of a county or a city not within a county.

35 ~~~~compensation for the first two days of service, but shall receive fifty dollars per day for the third day~~~~
36 ~~~~and each subsequent day he or she may actually serve as such, and seven cents for every mile he or~~~~
37 ~~~~she may necessarily travel going from his or her place of residence to the courthouse and returning,~~~~
38 ~~~~to be paid from funds of the county.] Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 or 2 of this~~
39 ~~section, by a majority vote, the court en banc of a judicial circuit may adopt a system for juror~~~~

1 compensation in a city not within a county or a county within the circuit, as follows: each grand or
2 petit juror shall receive fifty dollars per day for the third day the juror may actually serve as a juror
3 and for each subsequent day of actual service, and the mileage rate as provided by law for state
4 employees for every mile the juror may necessarily travel from the juror's place of residence to the
5 courthouse and returning, to be paid from funds of the county or a city not within a county; provided
6 that, no grand or petit juror shall receive compensation for the first two days the juror may actually
7 serve as such.

8 4. When each panel of jurors summoned and attending court has completed its service, the
9 board of jury commissioners shall cause to be submitted to the governing body of the county or a
10 city not within a county a statement of fees earned by each juror. Within thirty days of the
11 submission of the statement of fees, the governing body shall cause payment to be made to those
12 jurors summoned the fees earned during their service as jurors."; and
