1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2552, Page 4, Section 210.225, Line 29,  
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful possession of a firearm if such  
5 person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:

6 (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state, or of a crime  
7 under the laws of any state or of the United States which, if committed within this state, would be a  
8 felony; ~~or~~

9 (2) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated or drugged  
10 condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent; or

11 (3) Such person is under eighteen years of age and is on public property. However,  
12 possession under this subdivision is not an offense if such person possesses the firearm:

13 (a) While accompanied by a person twenty-one years of age or older;

14 (b) For the purposes of a school-sanctioned, firearm-related event or club event;

15 (c) For the lawful pursuit of game; or

16 (d) As otherwise authorized by law.

17 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class D felony, unless a person has been convicted  
18 of a dangerous felony as defined in section 556.061, in which case it is a class C felony.

19 3. The provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section shall not apply to the  
20 possession of an antique firearm."; and

22 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
23 accordingly.
