1 AMEND House Bill No. 2701, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and  
2 line the following:

4 "37.006. 1. The commissioner of administration is authorized and empowered to prescribe  
5 policies providing for increases in the salaries of all Missouri state employees. Beginning January  
6 1, 2025, and every two years thereafter, the commissioner of administration shall submit a salary  
7 schedule report to the governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tem of  
8 the senate. The salary schedule report prepared by the commissioner of administration shall  
9 include, in addition to other matters deemed pertinent to the commissioner of administration, a  
10 comparison of the salaries and benefits of all state employees employed by the office of  
11 administration of following states:

12 (1) Iowa;

13 (2) Nebraska;

14 (3) Illinois;

15 (4) Kentucky;

16 (5) Tennessee;

17 (6) Arkansas;

18 (7) Oklahoma; and

19 (8) Kansas.

20 2. The governor may make additional recommendations to the report and forward them to  
21 the speaker of the house of representatives and the president pro tem of the senate. The speaker of  
22 the house of representatives and the president pro tem of the senate may assign the salary schedule  
23 report to the appropriate standing committees to review the salary comparisons to ensure that parity  
24 in the salary of state employees of the three largest states is maintained. The commissioner of  
25 administration shall testify before the appropriate committee on the salary schedule report if called  
26 upon by such committee."; and

28 Further Amend said bill and page, Section 43.080, Lines 2-3, by deleting the words "Each year,  
29 prior to January first" and inserting in lieu there of the following:
