AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2700, Pages 2-3, Section 43.650, Lines 1-38, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
"43.652. 1. The patrol shall, subject to appropriation, maintain a web page on the internet
that shall be open to the public and shall include a violent offender search capability.
2. The violent offender search shall make it possible for any person using the internet to
search for and find the information specified in subsection 4 of this section, if known, on violent
offenders in this state pursuant to section 589.437.
3. The violent offender search shall include the capability to search for violent offenders by
name, by zip code, and by typing in an address and specifying a search within a certain number of
miles radius from that address.
4. Only the information listed in this subsection shall be provided to the public in the violent
offender search:
(1) The name and any known aliases of the offender;
(2) The date of birth and any known alias dates of birth of the offender;
(3) A physical description of the offender;
(4) The residence of the offender including the street address, city, county, state, and zip
<u>code;</u>
(5) Any photographs of the offender;
(6) The nature of all offenses qualifying the offender to register;
(7) The date on which the offender was released from the department of mental health,
prison, or jail, or placed on parole, supervised release, or probation for the offenses qualifying the
offender to appear on the search under this section"; and
Further amend said bill, Pages 58-59, Section 589.437, Lines 1-17, by deleting all of said lines and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:
"589.437. 1. For purposes of this section and section 43.652, the following persons shall be
known as violent offenders:
(1) Any person who is on probation or parole for:

1	(a) The offense of murder in the first degree under section 565.020;
2	(b) The offense of murder in the second degree under section 565.021; or
3	(c) An offense in a jurisdiction outside of this state that would qualify under paragraph (a)

5	(2) Any person who was found not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect of an offense
6	listed under subdivision (1) of this subsection.
7	2. The division of probation and parole of the department of corrections, or the department
8	of mental health if the person qualifies as a violent offender under subdivision (2) of subsection 1 of
9	this section, shall notify the Missouri state highway patrol of all information required under section
10	43.652 subsection 4, in a manner prescribed by the Missouri state highway patrol. Such notifications
11	shall take place if a violent offender is placed on probation or parole, is removed from probation or
12	parole, relocates to this state under the interstate compact for adult offender supervision, sections
13	589.500 to 589.569, or is found not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect, so that the Missouri
14	state highway patrol can update the offender registry described under section 43.652."; and
