FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact as the Public Service Commission is still able to assess actual cost per statute.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Facilities Management, Design and Construction (FMDC)** assume that this bill could increase utility costs to all state departments and local governments if rate changes are made. Without additional information, FMDC is unable to accurately calculate the impact of this bill; therefore, the impact is \$0 to unknown.

Oversight assumes this proposal could increase utility cost for the Office of Administration as well as other state agencies and local governments. Since it is unknown how much of a rate increase will be authorized (if any), Oversight will reflect a range from \$0 (no utility will increase rates) to an unknown cost to the state and local political subdivisions for higher utility costs, however, Oversight assumes the potential increase in utility cost will be under \$250,000.

Officials from the **Morgan County PWS** state that this proposal could have a fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of the State Treasurer, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, South River Drainage District, the St. Charles County Pwsd and the Wayne County Pwsd** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposal modifies provisions related to utility rates.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
