<u>§§510.500, 510.503, 510.506, 510.509, 510.512, 510.515, 510.518, 510.521 – Uniform Interstate</u> Depositions and Discovery Act

In response to similar legislation from 2023, SB 394, officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** stated there may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Department of Revenue, the Office of Administration, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services and the Office of the State Public Defender each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.
