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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

To implement the proposed changes, the Department will be required to:

- Update procedures, correspondence letters, forms, and the Department website;
- Update the Missouri Titling manual;
- Send communications to stakeholders as applicable; and
- Train Staff.

<u>FY 2025 – Motor Vehicle Bureau</u> Associate Research/Data Analyst 40 hrs. @ \$25.22 per hr. = \$1,009 Research/Data Assistant 25 hrs. @ \$27.00 per hr. = \$675

Administrative Manager 10 hrs. @ \$29.31 per hr. = \$293

<u>FY 2025 – Systems Analysis and Support</u> Research/Data Analyst 7 hrs. @ \$27.00 per hr. = \$189 Administrative Manager 4 hrs. @ \$29.31 per hr. = \$117 Associate Research/Data Analyst 27 hrs. @ \$21.64 per hr. = \$584

<u>FY 2025 – Strategy and Communications Office</u> Research/Data Analyst Assistant 10 hrs. @ 27.00 per hr. = 270Associate Research/Data Analyst 20 hrs. @ 21.64 per hr. = 216

Total Costs = \$3,353

The Department anticipates that they will be able to absorb these costs. If multiple bills are passed that require Department resources, FTE may be requested through the appropriations process.

Oversight assumes DOR will use existing staff and will not hire additional FTE to conduct these activities; therefore, Oversight will not reflect the administrative costs DOR has indicated on the fiscal note.

DOR also notes OA-ITSD services will be required at a cost of **\$7,439** in FY 2025 (70.85 hours x \$105 per hour).

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Fusion Impact

Implementation Consultant \$250/hour x 100hrs = \$25,000

Oversight does not have information to the contrary and therefore, Oversight will also reflect the implementation consultant costs as provided by DOR.

DOR notes, the costs associated with these legislative changes may be outside of the current contract and identified programming work for DOR's incoming integrated system. As such, the department has included the potential costs associated with making the changes to the integrated system by the department's current vendor.

The fiscal impact estimated above is based on changes in the current mainframe and titling registration information processing systems. The implementation of this legislation will be coordinated with the integration of the Department's Motor Vehicle and Driver Licensing software system approved and passed by the General Assembly in 2020 (SB 176). To avoid duplicative technology development and associated costs to the state, it is recommended a delayed effective date be added to this bill to correlate with the installation of the new system.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for MoDOT.
