§537.580 – Civil Liability for Employers Hiring Ex-Offenders Act

Officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Office of Administration, the Phelps County Sheriff's Office, the Branson Police Department, the Kansas City Police Department and the St. Louis County Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
