FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§205.160 & 205.190 – Establishment of Hospitals

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **City of Kansas City** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties and hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

Oversight notes this bill gives authority to all county commissions to establish, construct, equip, improve, extend, repair and maintain public hospitals, engage in health care activities and issue bonds. Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive to those counties that were previously excluded. Oversight assumes no fiscal impact from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Currently, with the exception of counties of the third and fourth classification where there already exists a hospital organized under Chapter 96, 205, or 206, RSMo, county commissions are authorized to establish, construct, equip, improve, extend, repair, and maintain public hospitals, engage in health care activities, and issue bonds. This bill removes the exception for hospitals established under the provisions of Chapters 96 and 206 in counties of the third and fourth classification.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
