FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

A \$15.00 fee will be collected at the time of application and registration. The new design would include both stock and personalized for specialty plates. There will be a \$125 design fee and an additional \$45 fee when creating a new plate design.

Administrative Impact

To implement the proposed legislation, the Department will be required to:

- Update charts, procedures and the Department website;
- Update the Application for Missouri Personalized and Special License Plate (DOR-1716, and DOR-4601); and
- Complete programming and user acceptance testing for identified systems.

The department will absorb the cost; however, if several bills pass, they will seek appropriations through the budget process.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.

DOR notes OA-ITSD services will be required at a cost of **\$14,506** in FY 2025 (138.15 hours x \$105 per hour).

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary in regards to DOR's assumptions; therefore, Oversight will reflect DOR's OA-ITSD costs on the fiscal note.

FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill creates special vehicle license plates for veterans who served in Afghanistan and Iraq.

The bill specifies that any person who served in Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom, and is either currently serving or honorably discharged, can apply for the plates by providing proof of service and paying a\$15 fee. The plates can be personalized at no extra cost.

The bill states that there is no limit on the number of plates a person can obtain, as long as he or she owns the vehicle, and that the plates are not transferable to anyone else.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
