Officials from the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Phelps County Sheriff's Office, the Kansas City Police Department and the St. Louis County Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from 2023, Perfected HCS for HB 1015, officials from the **Branson Police Department** and the **St. Joseph Police Department** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
