FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

<u>Sections 115.124, 162.491, 162.492, 162.860, and 162.910 – School Board Filing Location</u>

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** and the **Office of the Secretary of State** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the Jackson County Board of Elections, the Platte County Board of Elections, the St. Louis City Board of Elections, and the St. Louis County Board of Elections each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Greene County Clerk's Office** assume the cost increase for this bill would be approximately \$2,000 per year for supplies and legal notices.

Oversight assumes that costs from the implementation of this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities, county clerks, and school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.
