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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes the 23rd Judicial Circuit is currently not on-boarded with Oversight to receive legislation for response. In addition, officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact for this proposal. Oversight notes the 23rd Judicial Circuit is for Jefferson County and has based their estimates using the following information below.

Oversight assumes this proposal adds a surcharge of \$45 on civil circuit cases, in addition to all other court costs now or hereafter required by law or court rule, at the time of filing a suit and expires on August 28, 2045. Below is a 5 year average of the civil cases in the 23rd Judicial Circuit for Jefferson County. Oversight assumes taking \$45 per civil case and multiplying that against the 5 year average of cases filed, or 9,941, would result in \$447,345 per year in revenue for the 23rd Judicial Circuit for the construction of a new courthouse. Therefore, Oversight will reflect revenues of up to \$447,345 annually for this proposal.

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FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

Small businesses filing civil cases in the 23rd Judicial Circuit would be impacted by this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill specifies that associate circuit and circuit judges of the 23rd judicial circuit in St. Charles County will require parties filing a civil suit to pay a surcharge of \$45, which will be deposited into a courthouse construction fund. Funds will be used for the construction of a new courthouse in the circuit. These provisions will expire on August 28, 2045.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
