## **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for DNR.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** assume this proposal could have a negative fiscal impact on Kansas City in an indeterminate amount if it increases the cost of operating or contracting for the operation of a solid waste disposal area because there is a failure to obtain approval from an adjoining municipality.

Oversight assumes this proposal mandates DNR not to issue a permit for the operation of a solid waste disposal area if the respective county has not sought approval from an adjoining municipality for a site that is located within one mile of the adjoining municipality. Oversight assumes there will be no <u>direct</u> fiscal impact to the City of Kansas City for not being able to obtain a permit.

Officials from the **City of Osceola** assume there will be a fiscal impact but did not state what that impact would be.

**Oversight** cannot determine what fiscal impact there would be to the **City of Osceola**; therefore, Oversight will not reflect a fiscal impact.
