#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§221.360 – Jail Expenses to House Inmates or Detainees from Another County or City

Officials from the **Department of Corrections**, the **Attorney General's Office**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Office of the State Public Defender** and the **St. Louis County Police Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, and local law enforcement agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

**Oversight** assumes certain local political subdivisions would receive income and/or pay out reimbursements for the housing of inmates or detainees from another local political subdivision that would net to zero. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 or unknown income and a \$0 or unknown cost that will net to zero for this proposal.

# FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill specifies that if a county or city, as described in the bill, houses an inmate or detainee who is a resident of another county or city, the city or county of residence must reimburse the city or county that houses the inmate or detainee for the daily cost of housing. Upon enactment this bill applies to St. Louis City, St. Louis County, and St. Charles County.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
