ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes HCS for HB 2314 adds language requiring a request for qualification for all master agreements to be published in a newspaper, once per week for two consecutive weeks in the county or counties where the master agreement services are to be performed. Oversight assumes the cost associated with publishing will be immaterial and will not reflect a fiscal impact as result.
