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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Facilities Management, Design and Construction (FMDC)** assume there would be a fiscal impact to the State's utility costs. However, without more information FMDC is unable to calculate the impact this would have on statewide utility costs for consolidated facilities managed by FMDC; \$0 to unknown impact

Oversight assumes this proposal could potentially increase utility cost for the Office of Administration as well as other state agencies and local governments. Since it is unknown how much of a rate increase will be authorized (if any), Oversight will reflect a range from \$0 (rate increases will not occur) to an unknown cost to the state and local political subdivisions for higher utility costs.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation**, **Kansas City**, the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District**, the **South River Drainage District** and the **St. Charles County Pwsd** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.
