§442.671 - Uniform Easement Relocation Act

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Natural Resources, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Office of the Secretary of State, Kansas City, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, the South River Drainage District and the State Tax Commission each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to a previous version, officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration and the Wayne County PWSD #2 each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, utility districts and electric companies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
