AN ACT

To repeal section 194.321, RSMo, relating to organ transplant procedures.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 194.321, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2	(1) "COVID 19 vaccination status", an indication of whether a person has received a vaccination against COVID-19;
_	has received a vaccination against COVID-19:
3	has received a vaccination against ee vib 13,
4	(2) "Hospital", the same meaning given to the term in section 197.020;
5	(3) "Procurement organization", the same meaning given to the term in
6	section 194.210.
7	2. Except if the organ being transplanted is a lung, no hospital,
8	physician, procurement organization, or other person shall consider the
9	COVID-19 vaccination status of a potential organ transplant recipient or
10	potential organ donor in any part of the organ transplant process including, but
11	not limited to:
12	(1) The referral of a patient to be considered for a transplant;
13	(2) The evaluation of a patient for a transplant;
14	(3) The consideration of a patient for placement on a waiting list;
15	(4) A patient's particular position on a waiting list; and
16	(5) The evaluation of a potential donor to determine his or her
17	suitability as an organ donor.]
