AN ACT

To amend chapter 376, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to insurance coverage of self-administered hormonal contraceptives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 376, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 376.1240, to read as follows:

376.1240. 1. For purposes of this section, terms shall have the same meanings as 2 ascribed to them in section 376.1350, and the term "self-administered hormonal 3 contraceptive" shall mean a drug composed of one or more hormones and is approved by the Food and Drug Administration to prevent pregnancy.

- 2. Any health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed 6 in this state on or after January 1, 2025, that provides coverage for self-administered hormonal contraceptives shall provide coverage to reimburse a health care provider or dispensing entity for the dispensing of a supply of self-administered hormonal contraceptives intended to last up to one year.
- 3. The coverage required under this section shall not be subject to any greater 10 deductible or co-payment than other similar health care services provided by the health benefit plan.
