## AN ACT

To amend chapter 233, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to residents of county special road districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 233, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 233.318 and 233.446, to read as follows:

233.318. 1. No resident of a county special road district organized under sections 2 233.170 to 233.317 shall be considered a qualified voter for purposes of signing petitions or voting on ballot issues related to county roads outside the resident's county special road district.

2. This section shall apply to petitions circulated and ballot issues appearing on a ballot, as such petitions and ballot issues are described in subsection 1 of this section, on and after August 28, 2024.

233.446. 1. No resident of a county special road district organized under sections 2 233.320 to 233.445 shall be considered a qualified voter for purposes of signing petitions or voting on ballot issues related to county roads outside the resident's county special road district.

2. This section shall apply to petitions circulated and ballot issues appearing on a ballot, as such petitions and ballot issues are described in subsection 1 of this section, on and after August 28, 2024.
