AN ACT

To amend chapter 341, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to licensure reciprocity for plumbers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 341, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 341.240, to read as follows:

341.240. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

- (1) "Plumber's license", any license, certificate, registration, or permit that enables an individual to legally engage in the business of plumbing in a particular jurisdiction after passing a test approved by a plumber-training body;
- (2) "Plumber-training body", any entity that is recognized by the plumbing industry as having expertise in the business of plumbing and that provides training or training materials on plumbing skills.
- 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any political subdivision that requires an individual to obtain a plumber's license before engaging in 10 the business of plumbing in the political subdivision shall recognize a valid current plumber's license issued by another political subdivision in the state as sufficient for its purposes and waive its own licensure requirement for the license holder if the license holder successfully passed an examination approved by a plumber-training body in 14 order to obtain the plumber's license from the other political subdivision. The license
- 15 holder still shall get a business license in the other political subdivision.

3. Reciprocity shall be extended to the holder of a license issued before August 28, 2024, if the holder had to pass a test to obtain the license.
