AN ACT

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to insurance requirements for firearm owners.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 571.900, to read as follows:

571.900. 1. Any person who resides in this state and owns or possesses a firearm in this state shall obtain and continuously maintain in full force and effect a homeowner's, renter's, or firearm liability insurance policy from an insurer authorized to transact insurance in this state specifically covering losses or damages resulting from any accidental use of the firearm including, but not limited to, death, injury, and property damage.

- 2. For purposes of this section, a person shall be deemed to be the owner of a firearm if such firearm is lost or stolen until such loss or theft is reported to the local law enforcement agency in the jurisdiction in which the firearm owner resides.
- 3. Any person who owns a firearm on the effective date of this section shall obtain the insurance required by this section within thirty days of the effective date of this section.
