## AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to local ballot proposals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 67.007, to read as follows:

67.007. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, beginning August 28, 2024, if any proposal by any political subdivision to impose a new tax authorized by a specific statute or to increase the rate of an existing tax authorized by a specific statute is submitted to and rejected by the voters of the political subdivision, such proposal shall not be resubmitted to the voters at any time during the four years immediately following the rejection.

Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section to the contrary,
a political subdivision may resubmit to the voters a previously rejected tax proposal
sooner than the four years immediately following its rejection if the new proposal states
a substantial change. For the purposes of this section, a "substantial change" means:
(1) A reduction equal to or greater than twenty-five percent of the rate of tax

12 imposed by the previously rejected proposal; or

13 (2) A dedicated fund other than the dedicated fund stated in the previously14 rejected proposal.
