### AN ACT

To repeal section 210.275, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to child care providers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 210.275, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 210.275, to read as follows:

210.275. Any program licensed by the department of elementary and secondary 2 education pursuant to this chapter providing child care to **only** school-age children [that is

3 located and operated on elementary or secondary school property] shall comply with the

4 child-care licensure provisions in this chapter; except that, for safety, health and fire purposes,

5 all buildings and premises for any such programs shall be deemed to be in compliance with

6 the child-care licensure provisions in this chapter.
