AN ACT

To repeal section 441.043, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to local government ordinances for rental property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 441.043, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 441.043, to read as follows:

441.043. No county or city, or county or city with a charter form of government may 2 enact, maintain, or enforce any ordinance or resolution which regulates the amount of rent to

- 3 be charged for privately-owned, single-family, or multiple-unit residential or commercial
- 4 rental property. No county or city, or county or city with a charter form of government,
- 5 shall enact, maintain, or enforce any ordinance or resolution that prohibits landlords
- 6 from refusing to lease or rent a privately owned, single-family, or multiple-unit 7 residential or commercial rental property to a person because the person's lawful source
- of income to pay rent includes funding from a federal housing assistance program. This

 - section shall not be construed as prohibiting any county or city, or any authority created by a county or city for that purpose, from:
 - (1) Regulating in any way property belonging to that city, county, or authority;
- 12 (2) Entering into agreements with private persons which regulate the amount of rent charged for subsidized rental properties; or 13
- (3) Enacting ordinances or resolutions restricting rent for properties assisted with 15 community development block grant funds.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
