## AN ACT

To repeal section 574.120, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the offense of making a terrorist threat in the second degree, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 574.120, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 574.120, to read as follows:

574.120. 1. A person commits the offense of making a terrorist threat in the second 2 degree if he or she recklessly disregards the risk of causing the evacuation, quarantine or 3 closure of any portion of a building, inhabitable structure, place of assembly or facility of transportation and knowingly:

- (1) Communicates an express or implied threat to cause an incident or condition 6 involving danger to life; or
- 7 (2) Communicates a false report of an incident or condition involving danger to life; 8 or
- 9 (3) Causes a false belief or fear that an incident has occurred or that a condition exists involving danger to life.
- 11 2. The offense of making a terrorist threat in the second degree is a class E felony, unless such offense caused death, bodily injury, or property damage then it shall be a 12 13 class D felony.
- 14 3. No offense is committed under this section by a person acting in good faith with 15 the purpose to prevent harm.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
