AN ACT

To repeal sections 579.065 and 579.068, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to offenses involving the trafficking of drugs, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 579.065 and 579.068, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 579.065 and 579.068, to read as follows:

579.065. 1. A person commits the offense of trafficking drugs in the first degree if, 2 except as authorized by this chapter or chapter 195, such person knowingly distributes, 3 delivers, manufactures, produces or attempts to distribute, deliver, manufacture or produce:

4 (1) More than thirty grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount 5 of heroin;

6 (2) More than one hundred fifty grams of a mixture or substance containing a 7 detectable amount of coca leaves, except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves from which 8 cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their salts have been removed; cocaine salts 9 and their optical and geometric isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their 10 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture, or preparation which contains 11 any quantity of any of the foregoing substances;

12 (3) More than eight grams of a mixture or substance described in subdivision (2) of 13 this subsection which contains cocaine base;

14 (4) More than five hundred milligrams of a mixture or substance containing a15 detectable amount of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD);

16 (5) More than thirty grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount 17 of phencyclidine (PCP);

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

2. The offense of trafficking drugs in the first degree is a class B felony.

35 3. The offense of trafficking drugs in the first degree is a class A felony if the quantity36 involved is:

37 (1) Ninety grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of38 heroin; or

39 (2) Four hundred fifty grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a 40 detectable amount of coca leaves, except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves from which 41 cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their salts have been removed; cocaine salts 42 and their optical and geometric isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their 43 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture, or preparation which contains 44 any quantity of any of the foregoing substances; or

45 (3) Twenty-four grams or more of a mixture or substance described in subdivision (2)46 of this subsection which contains cocaine base; or

47 (4) One gram or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of 48 lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD); or

49 (5) Ninety grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of50 phencyclidine (PCP); or

(6) Twelve grams or more of phencyclidine; or

(10) Ninety grams or more of any material, compound, mixture or preparation which
 contains any quantity of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine; or

73 (11) More than thirty grams of any material, compound, mixture, or preparation 74 which contains any quantity of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine and the location of the 75 offense was within two thousand feet of real property comprising a public or private 76 elementary, vocational, or secondary school, college, community college, university, or any 77 school bus, in or on the real property comprising public housing or any other governmental 78 assisted housing, within a motor vehicle, or in any structure or building which contains rooms furnished for the accommodation or lodging of guests, and kept, used, maintained, advertised, 79 80 or held out to the public as a place where sleeping accommodations are sought for pay or 81 compensation to transient guests or permanent guests; or

(12) One gram or more of flunitrazepam for a second or subsequent offense; or

579.068. 1. A person commits the offense of trafficking drugs in the second degree 2 if, except as authorized by this chapter or chapter 195, such person knowingly possesses or 3 has under his or her control, purchases or attempts to purchase, or brings into this state:

4 (1) More than thirty grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount 5 of heroin;

6 (2) More than one hundred fifty grams of a mixture or substance containing a 7 detectable amount of coca leaves, except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves from which 8 cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their salts have been removed; cocaine salts 9 and their optical and geometric isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their 10 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture, or preparation which contains 11 any quantity of any of the foregoing substances;

12 (3) More than eight grams of a mixture or substance described in subdivision (2) of 13 this subsection which contains cocaine base;

14 (4) More than five hundred milligrams of a mixture or substance containing a15 detectable amount of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD);

16 (5) More than thirty grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount 17 of phencyclidine (PCP);

mixture, or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl [or carfentanil], or [their] its
optical isomers or analogues; or

(11) Any amount of carfentanil.

2. The offense of trafficking drugs in the second degree is a class C felony.

33 3. The offense of trafficking drugs in the second degree is a class B felony if the 34 quantity involved is:

(1) Ninety grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount ofheroin; or

37 (2) Four hundred fifty grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a 38 detectable amount of coca leaves, except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves from which 39 cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their salts have been removed; cocaine salts 40 and their optical and geometric isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their 41 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture, or preparation which contains 42 any quantity of any of the foregoing substances; or

43 (3) Twenty-four grams or more of a mixture or substance described in subdivision (2)44 of this subsection which contains cocaine base; or

45 (4) One gram or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of 46 lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD); or

47 (5) Ninety grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of 48 phencyclidine (PCP); or

(6) Twelve grams or more of phencyclidine; or

4. The offense of trafficking drugs in the second degree is a class A felony if the
quantity involved is four hundred fifty grams or more of any material, compound, mixture or
preparation which contains:

(1) Any quantity of the following substances having a stimulant effect on the central
nervous system: amphetamine, its salts, optical isomers and salts of its optical isomers;
methamphetamine, its salts, isomers and salts of its isomers; phenmetrazine and its salts; or
methylphenidate; or

(2) Any quantity of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine.

5. The offense of drug trafficking in the second degree is a class C felony for the first offense and a class B felony for any second or subsequent offense for the trafficking of less than one gram of flunitrazepam.
