## AN ACT

To amend chapter 170, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to marijuana usage education in public schools.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 170, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 170.378, to read as follows:

3 **170.378. 1. The state board of education shall convene a work group to develop**  
4 **and recommend academic performance standards relating to a minimum of one hour of**  
5 **marijuana usage education in each school year. The work group shall include, but not**  
6 **be limited to, representatives from local health departments and local law enforcement**  
7 **agencies. The work group shall develop written curriculum frameworks relating to**  
8 **marijuana usage education that are designed to ensure that students twelve years of age**  
9 **or older learn the dangers of marijuana usage.**

10 **2. The state board of education shall adopt and implement academic**  
11 **performance standards relating to marijuana usage education for the 2025-26 school**  
12 **year and all subsequent school years.**

13 **3. The requirements of section 160.514 shall not apply to this section.**
