	WHEREAS, the Executive Branch of the United States has a constitutional duty to
2	enforce federal laws protecting states, including immigration laws; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, President Biden has violated his oath to faithfully execute immigration
5	laws by suing Texas for taking action to secure the border instead of prosecuting illegal
6	immigrants; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, President Biden has instructed his agencies to ignore federal statutes
9	that mandate the detention of illegal immigrants; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, President Biden has wasted taxpayer dollars to tear open Texas's border
12	security infrastructure; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, due to President Biden's lawless border policies, more than six million
15	illegal immigrants have crossed the southern border in just three years; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the U.S. Constitution promises the federal government shall protect
18	each state against invasion and acknowledges the sovereign interest of each state in protecting
19	its borders; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, in the face of the Biden Administration's failure to fulfill the duties
22	imposed by the Constitution, Texas Governor Greg Abbott has invoked Texas's constitutional
23	authority to defend and protect itself; and

25	WHEREAS, the Texas National Guard, the Texas Department of Public Safety, and
26	other Texas personnel are acting on that authority to secure the southern border; and

WHEREAS, other states, including Arkansas, Tennessee, Iowa, and South Dakota, have sent National Guard members to protect the borders of the United States, prevent illegal entry, and deter illicit activity and other threats; and

WHEREAS, resources of the state of Missouri, including the Missouri National
Guard, are or may be needed to help secure the border of the United States in the state of
Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri National Guard members can provide operational, surveillance, engineering, administrative, and mechanical support to border, national, and state security and law enforcement agencies; and

40 **WHEREAS,** the State of Missouri should assist in the efforts to secure the borders of 41 the United States in the state of Texas:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of
 Representatives of the One Hundred Second General Assembly, Second Regular Session,
 hereby support the actions taken by Governor Abbott to secure the southern border; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Missouri House of Representatives strongly
 condemns the failure of the Biden Administration to faithfully execute U.S. immigration laws
 and secure the southern border; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hereby urge the Governor of the state of Missouri to order the Adjutant General of the state of Missouri, or his designee, to call upon and order into active service such portions of the organized militia, including the Missouri National Guard, to aid the officials of Texas in the protection of the borders of the United States and to take such action and employ such equipment as may be necessary in support of security and law enforcement authorities in the defense of the border of United States; and
