AN ACT

Relating to amyloidosis awareness day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

WHEREAS, amyloidosis is a rare disease of which there are several types, one of which is similar to blood cancer and another that is commonly inherited; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the combination of all types of amyloidosis affect thousands of people in the United States; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, the medial length of survival for an amyloidosis patient who does not receive treatment is less than three years; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, many patients go undiagnosed every year and special initiatives can raise public awareness and save lives; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the early diagnosis of amyloidosis in conjunction with prompt treatments not only improves the quality of life but extends life expectancy: 15 16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of 17 Representatives of the One Hundred Second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby designate May eighth each year as amyloidosis awareness 18 19 day; and
