AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 191.230, to read as follows:

**191.230. No public school district or public charter school shall require a
2 student, as a condition of enrollment, as a condition of attendance at a school event or
3 activity, or for any other reason, to:**

4 **(1) Receive a dose of messenger ribonucleic acid;**

5 **(2) Receive any treatment or procedure intended or designed to edit or alter
6 human deoxyribonucleic acid or the human genome; or**

7 **(3) Have placed under the student's skin any mechanical or electronic device.**
