## AN ACT

To repeal section 571.070, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to unlawful possession of a firearm, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 571.070, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 571.070, to read as follows:

571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful possession of a firearm if such person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:

- (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state, or of a crime under the laws of any state or of the United States which, if committed within this state, would be a felony; [or]
- (2) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated or drugged condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent; or
- 8 (3) Such person is under eighteen years of age and is on public property.
  9 However, possession under this subdivision is not an offense if such person possesses the
  10 firearm:
  - (a) While accompanied by a person twenty-one years of age or older;
- 12 (b) For the purposes of a school-sanctioned, firearm-related event or club event;
  - (c) For the lawful pursuit of game; or
- 14 (d) As otherwise authorized by law.
- 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class D felony, unless a person has been
- 16 convicted of a dangerous felony as defined in section 556.061, in which case it is a class C
- 17 felony.
