AN ACT

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the task force on the marketing of cannabis and cannabinoid products to children and pregnant women.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 195.807, to read as follows:

195.807. 1. There is hereby established the "Task Force on the Marketing of Cannabis and Cannabinoid Products to Children and Pregnant Women".

- 2. The task force shall consist of not more than twenty members. The members shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 5 (1) One member of the house of representatives;
- 6 (2) One member of the senate;
- 7 (3) A pediatrician;
- 8 (4) A physician specializing in obstetrics and gynecology;
- 9 (5) A maternal-fetal medicine physician;
- 10 (6) A neonatologist;
- 11 (7) A public health expert;
- 12 **(8)** A public safety expert;
- 13 (9) A representative of the department of health and senior services;
- 14 (10) A representative of the department of elementary and secondary education;
- 15 and
- 16 (11) A representative of the department of transportation.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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- 3. Members of the task force shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.
 - 4. The task force shall study the current marketing of cannabis and cannabinoid products to children and pregnant women in this state and make recommendations on whether and how such marketing should be further regulated and restricted.
 - 5. Before September 1, 2025, and before September first every year thereafter, the task force shall compile an annual report of its activities in the preceding fiscal year ending June thirtieth and submit the report to the governor and the general assembly.

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
