2           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly has a long tradition of granting the use of the  
3 House of Representatives Chamber for programs aimed at developing qualities of citizenship  
4 and leadership within our youth; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the Missouri Constitution Project gives students exciting, hands-on  
6 experience in possible future careers that are integral to the United States Constitution and the  
7 nation and provides participants with a greater understanding of, and love for, the U.S.  
8 Constitution through personal experience in the constitutional system, including concepts  
9 such as freedom of the press, due process, and the right to trial by jury; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the Missouri Constitution Project became a statewide competition in  
12 2013 and has imparted valuable lessons and experiences in Missouri youth every year since:

14           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri  
15 House of Representatives, One Hundred Second General Assembly, hereby grant the  
16 Missouri Constitution Project use of the House Chamber on Wednesday, September 18, 2024,  
17 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of conducting the 2024 Constitution Project; and

19           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sponsor of this House Resolution,  
20 Representative Cook, or his designee, shall be present in the House Chamber and shall  
21 assume responsibility for the group's actions for the duration of the aforementioned event.

23 *Special note:* Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner  
24 that preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall  
25 behave respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and  
26 smoking are prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall  
27 refrain from any conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

28           Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the  
29 microphone to speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is  
30 prohibited.

31           Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains,  
32 or any surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including  
33 computers, phones, or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited.
